

We would like to welcome you onboard 'Rails to the West'. A 6 day getaway focusing on a pair of main centres up the North Island's West Coast -Whanganui & New Plymouth.

As we venture toward's Whanganui onboard our heritage train, we sample some delights of the early 20th century, with our visit to Whanganui on our journey north west. In 1880, James Moore established a large farm on the estate north of Whanganui. Within this, 99 hectares (245 acres) of native lowland forest was preserved, and this is now the Bushy Park Tarapuruhi reserve. The forest reserve and the homestead in which we get to exclusively dine in, was built for Frank Moore in 1906, were gifted to the Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand in 1962.

A visit to Whanganui's historical Sarjeant Gallery will be sure to go down as a favourite. Announced by National Geographic in 2024 as a "Best of the World Pick", holds a collection of more than 8,000 items of national and international significance, spanning four centuries of European and New Zealand art history, and is the result of Henry Sarjeant's generosity to his home city of Whanganui.

Salvaged from the bottom of the Whanganui River where she sat for around 50 years, the Paddle Steamer Waimarie was restored to her former glory and re-launched in 2000 to make her New Zealand's only authentic coal-fired paddle steamer in operation. Our sailing on the Waimarie is a beautiful nod to her 126 year legacy which continues well into the 21st century for all to experience.

Heading further north, we fast forward a few decades, and immerse ourselves in the AmeriCARna festival, an annual highlight for New Plymouth, and the wider car community all over the country. We learn about what over the last 15 years, has come to be one of the country's most popular car events, the history behind it, before we immerse ourselves in the action. Following a day at leisure, exploring New Plymouth and the beautiful surrounds. spend the final day relaxing onboard our heritage train back to Wellington, to conclude a fantastic experience away with Steam Incorporated.

For 6 days, let us take the stress out of your travel, with our tour guide team who are available at any hour to take care of any thing that is not to your satisfaction. Our aim is to redefine your heritage rail experience, and create a life time of memories that you can look back on.








DAY 3 - A TASTE OF THE WEEKEND Whanganui - New Plymouth | Heritage Train, Coach


Day 4 - Immerse in the Muscle New Plymouth | Coach , Heritage Train

Day 5 - Explore The West New Plymouth | Coach

Pop into Puke Ariki for interactive local history and a café, then dive into contemporary art at the Govett-Brewster/ Len Lye Centre. Finish by exploring heritage gems: the stone-built St Mary's Church, or the lush Huatoki Walkway through town. Perfect for a relaxing yet vibrant city adventure.
